

The main points from the op-ed are:

- We're calling on the Government to develop an economic plan to support Australia to realise the economic and productivity opportunities from AI.
- We support the government publishing a whole-of-government strategy for how it will regulate AI while also supporting economic opportunity, as the UK Government has done, and establishing a whole-ofgovernment taskforce to coordinate activity.
- We also support reform of existing laws to keep pace with AI and keep Australians safe, including in key areas such as privacy law, liability law and administrative law. Related to this, we support the government identifying where there are other gaps in law or practice and want to work with Government to address these.
