The centrepiece of your visit is a bilateral with the newly appointed Minister for Trade, Industry and Energy (MOTIE), <u>Ahn</u> Duk-Geun who was confirmed by the National Assembly on 3 January 2024.

- Minister Ahn, an expert in international trade and commerce, was promoted from his
 previous role as Minister for Trade. The previous MOTIE Minister, <u>Bang</u> Moon-kyu,
 stepped down to run in April's general elections.
