Re: Application for Accelerated Reviews on aluminium road wheels

Dear Sir/Madam,

I am writing to you apply for an accelerated review on behalf of Changzhou Science & Technology Co., Ltd (hereinafter referred as "Changzhou").

"Changzhou" was founded in 2004, as a private limited liability company, and mainly manufactures aluminium road wheels.

"Changzhou" mainly focuses on developing domestic market before, now intends to exploit Australian market due to the change of company's strategy.



1. Description of the goods to which the notice relates.

The Anti-Dumping Commission's (the Commission) Report No. 181, which outlines

the findings of the most recent review and is the basis for the current anti-dumping and subsidy measures, describes the goods as follows:

aluminium road wheels.

2. Grounds for review

No export to Australia up to date

A new exporter may request an accelerated review of a dumping duty notice, in so far as that notice affects that exporter.

New exporter is defined under s.269T of the Customs Act 1901 as:

an exporter who did not export such goods to Australia at any time during the period:

(a) Starting at the start of the investigation period in relation to the application;

and

(b) Ending immediately before the day the Commissioner places on the public record the statement of essential facts in relation to the investigation of the application.

"Changzhou " does not export any subject products to Australia.

Related to investigated exporters

The Commissioner may reject the application if satisfied in accordance with s.269ZE(2)(b) that:

the exporter is related to an exporter whose exports were examined in relation to the application for publication of that notice;

"Changzhou " is a private company that was founded in 2004 and confirms that it is not related to any 'exporter whose exports were examined in relation to the application for publication of the notice'.

According to Customs Act 1901-Sect269ZF, I am in belief that "Changzhou " is qualified to apply for a review.

I will appreciate it very much if you could approve this application as soon as possible.
