## **SNOWTOWN II WIND FARM PROJECT**

## IMPORTS OF WIND TOWERS NOT FROM NOMINATED COUNTRIES

The Anti-Dumping Commission (the Commission) contacted Siemens Ltd (Siemens), the supplier of wind towers for the Snowtown II project in South Australia.

The Snowtown II project was claimed by the Australian industry in its application to be a tender for the supply of wind towers that was lost to the allegedly dumped exports from China in the investigation period. The Commission requested details from Siemens of its importations of wind towers for the Snowtown II project.

Siemens advised the Commission that the wind towers for the project were <u>not</u> imported from and were <u>not</u> the origin of China or Korea. Siemens provided documents to the Commission to support its statements.

The Commission has examined the documents provided and is satisfied that the wind towers for the Snowtown II wind project were <u>not</u> exported from or were <u>not</u> the origin of China or Korea.
