

ANTI-DUMPING NOTICE NO. 2015/08

Certain Hollow Structural Sections

Exported from the Republic of Korea

Extension of time granted to issue the Statement of Essential Facts

Customs Act 1901 - Part XVB

On 1 October 2014 I, Dale Seymour, the Commissioner of the Anti-Dumping Commission published a notice announcing the initiation of a review of anti-dumping measures in respect of certain hollow structural sections (HSS) exported to Australia from the Republic of Korea (Korea).

A full description of the goods is available in Anti-Dumping Notice (ADN) No. 2014/94. This ADN is available on the internet at www.adcommission.gov.au.

The initiation notice advised that a statement of essential facts (SEF) for the review would be placed on the public record by 19 January 2015. The SEF will set out the facts on which I propose to base my recommendations to the Minister for Industry and Science (the Minister).

Due to the complexity of the issues involved in the review, as well as extensions of time allowed for various interested parties to supply information, I requested an extension of the deadline for the publication of the SEF.

The Minister has, under section 269ZHI of the *Customs Act 1901*, extended the deadline for publication of the SEF. The SEF will now be placed on the public record no later than 4 March 2015. Interested parties are invited to make submissions to the Anti-Dumping Commission (the Commission) in response to the SEF within 20 days of the SEF being placed on the public record. A recommendation to the Minister will be made in a report due on or before 18 April 2015.
