Dear Mr Benussi.

On behalf of the Ministry of Economic Affairs of Taiwan, I would like to submit its comment on the Anti-Dumping Notice No. 2013/64 regarding power transformers exported from the People's Republic of China, the Republic of Indonesia, the Republic of Korea, Taiwan, Thailand and the Socialist Republic of Vietnam to Australia.

As to the products concerned (tariff subheading 8504.22.00 and 8504.23.00) and pursuant to the World Trade Atlas statistics of the import volumes (sourced from Australian Bureau of Statistics), my government would like to point out the percentage of imports on these products from Taiwan to Australia in 2008-2012 period were 0.1, 0, 0, 1.9 and 0.1 per cent respectively. Furthermore, the countries including Taiwan which individually account for less than 3 per cent of the imports of the like product collectively account for less than 7 per cent of imports of the like product in Australia from 2008 to 2012. According to Article 5.8 of Agreement on Implementation of Article VI of the General Agreement on Tariffs and Trade 1994, the margins should be considered to be de minimis or that the volume of imports, actual or potential, or the injury, is negligible. Attached please find the relevant statistics of the imports of the concerned products to Australia for your reference.

My government therefore contends that the Australian Anti-Dumping Commission should terminate the investigation on the power transformers exported from Taiwan to Australia in light of the evidence provided and the above-mentioned agreement.

## Agreement on implementation of article VI of the general agreement on tariffs and trade 1994 (Anti-dumping Agreement)

5.8 An application under paragraph 1 shall be rejected and an investigation shall be terminated promptly as soon as the authorities concerned are satisfied that there is not sufficient evidence of either dumping or of injury to justify proceeding with the case. There shall be immediate termination in cases where the authorities determine that the margin of dumping is *de minimis*, or that the volume of dumped imports, actual or potential, or the injury, is negligible. The margin of dumping shall be considered to be *de minimis* if this margin is less than 2 per cent, expressed as a percentage of the export price. The volume of dumped imports shall normally be regarded as negligible if the volume of dumped imports from a particular country is found to account for less than 3 per cent of imports of the like product in the importing Member, unless countries which individually account for less than 3 per cent of the imports of the like product in the importing Member.
