



ANTI-DUMPING NOTICE NO. 2015/19

Zinc Coated (Galvanised) Steel

Exported from the Republic of Korea

Extension of time granted to issue the Statement of Essential Facts

Customs Act 1901 – Part XVB

On 31 October 2014 I, Dale Seymour, the Commissioner of the Anti-Dumping Commission published a notice announcing the initiation of a review of anti-dumping measures in respect of certain zinc coated (galvanised) steel exported to Australia from the Republic of Korea by Dongbu Steel Co., Ltd.

A full description of the goods is available in Anti-Dumping Notice (ADN) No. 2014/120. This ADN is available on the internet at www.adcommission.gov.au.

The initiation notice advised that a statement of essential facts (SEF) for the review would be placed on the public record by 18 February 2015. The SEF will set out the facts on which I propose to base my recommendations to the Parliamentary Secretary to the Minister for Industry and Science (the Parliamentary Secretary).

Due to the requirement for additional time to properly analyse the information submitted by the exporter to establish whether the variable factors relevant to the taking of anti-dumping measures have changed in relation to Dongbu Steel Co., Ltd, I requested an extension of the deadline for the publication of the SEF under subsection 269ZH(1)(d) of the *Customs Act 1901* (the Act).

The Parliamentary Secretary has, under section 269ZH(3) of the Act, extended the deadline for publication of the SEF. The SEF will now be placed on the public record no later than 16 May 2015. Interested parties are invited to make submissions to the Anti-Dumping Commission (the Commission) in response to the SEF within 20 days of the SEF being placed on the public record. A recommendation to the Parliamentary Secretary will be made in a report due on or before 30 June 2015.
