HOLLOW STRUCTURAL SECTIONS EXPORTED FROM THAILAND

This submission, on behalf of Pacific Pipe Public Co Ltd, ("Pacific Pipe"), requests termination of the captioned investigation as it relates to Pacific Pipe.

This investigation was initiated by the Anti-Dumping Commission (ADC) on, among other things, its consideration that there are reasonable grounds to support Austube Mills Pty Ltd's ("ATM") claim that hollow structural sections ("HSS") has been exported from Thailand at dumped prices. It is paramount that –

- a) the said ADC's consideration is based on its assessment of normal values which are not relevant to Pacific Pipe's exports; and
- b) verifiable evidence before the ADC proves that Pacific Pipe's exports have not been made at dumped prices.

The normal values assessed by the Commission for the purpose of initiation, based on the theoretical weights of domestic sales and prices of unpainted circular hollow sections ("CHS") and rectangular hollow sections ("RHS") in those sales with certain adjustments², are substantially higher than the actual normal values of Pacific Pipe's exports during the investigation period ("IP") which are fairly comparable with export prices. The adjustments made by the Commission to ensure fair comparison with export prices are in relation to –

- port loading costs;
- containerisation costs;
- painting costs; and
- differences in weight tolerances.
