## INVESTIGATION INTO THE ALLEGED DUMPING OF HOT ROLLED STRUCTURAL STEEL EXPORTED TO AUSTRALIA FROM JAPAN, THE REPUBLIC OF KOREA, TAIWAN AND THAILAND

On 20 December 2013, the Anti-Dumping Commission (the Commission) notified you via email that the exporter questionnaire submitted on 13 December 2013 contained a number of deficiencies, and confirmed that your deadline for the submission of a fully completed exporter questionnaire remained 23 December 2013.

A fully completed exporter questionnaire is considered relevant information to enable the Commission to adequately determine whether dumping is occurring.

As a fully completed questionnaire response has not been received by the Commission by the due date, I am satisfied that Alexandra Asia Ent Co Ltd (Alexandra) did not give information relevant to the investigation within a reasonable period, and now consider Alexandra to be an uncooperative exporter as defined under section 269T(1) of the *Customs Act 1901* (the Act). Accordingly, a dumping margin for Alexandra will be determined in accordance with section 269TACAB(1) of the Act.

As an interested party, as defined under section 2609T(1) of the Act, Alexandra can still participate in the investigation by providing the Commission with submissions on any issues relevant to the consideration of the publication of a dumping duty notice.
