

ANTI-DUMPING NOTICE NO. 2014/97

Rod in coils

Exported from the Republic of Indonesia, Taiwan and the Republic of Turkey

Further extension of time granted to issue the Statement of Essential Facts

Customs Act 1901 - Part XVB

On 10 April 2014, the Anti-Dumping Commission (the Commission) published a notice announcing the initiation of an investigation into the alleged dumping of rod in coils exported to Australia from the Republic of Indonesia (Indonesia), Taiwan and the Republic of Turkey (Turkey).

A full description of the goods is available in Anti-Dumping Notice (ADN) No. 2014/27. This ADN is available on the internet at www.adcommission.gov.au.

The initiation notice advised that the statement of essential facts (SEF) for the investigation would be placed on the public record by 29 July 2014. The SEF will set out the facts on which I propose to base recommendations to the Parliamentary Secretary to the Minister for Industry (the Parliamentary Secretary) in relation to the application for dumping measures.

On 29 July 2014, the Commission advised that the Parliamentary Secretary had, under section 269ZHI of the *Customs Act 1901* (the Act), extended the deadline for the publication of the SEF to 17 October 2014.

The Commission has requested a further extension of time to the publication of the SEF to enable the Commission's completion of its offsite verification of exporter information from Turkey and Indonesia.

The Parliamentary Secretary has, under section 269ZHI of the Act, further extended the deadline for the publication of the SEF. The SEF will now be placed on the public record no later than **15 January 2015**.

Interested parties will be invited to make submissions to the Commission in response to the SEF within 20 days of the SEF being placed on the public record. A recommendation to the Parliamentary Secretary will now be made in a report due on or before 1 March 2015.
