



INVESTIGATION INTO ALLEGED DUMPING OF

CERTAIN CRYSTALLINE SILICONPHOTOVOLTAIC MODULES OR PANELS EXPORTED FROM THE PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF CHINA

NOTE FOR FILE– NINGBO QIXIN SOLAR ELECTRICAL APPLIANCE CO., LTD. – EXTENSION TO EXPORTER QUESTIONNAIRE

Background

On 15 May 2014, a consultant now representing Ningbo Qixin Solar Electrical Appliance Co. Ltd (QXPV) requested, and the Anti-Dumping Commission (the Commission), provided an exporter questionnaire regarding certain crystalline silicon photovoltaic modules or panels (PV modules or panels). QXPV is seeking its own individual dumping margin rate. The response to the exporter questionnaire was due by 25 June 2014.

On 19 June 2014, a consultant representing QXPV wrote to the Commission seeking an extension until 9 July 2014.

The reasons for the extension are as follows:

- QXPV claims that there are some aspects of the questionnaire that seeks information which is not readily available.
- Some of the source documentation requested in Section H of the questionnaire is requiring a fair degree of effort to recover and translate in English.

Decision

After carefully considering QXPV's request and taking into account the strict legislative timeframes, the Commission granted QXPV an extension of one week. The Commission expects the questionnaire response to be complete in all respects in the first instance including filing in the public record version of the questionnaire by this date.

The responses to the exporter questionnaire from QXPV are now due by **2 July 2014**.
