**INVESTIGATION INTO THE ALLEGED DUMPING AND SUBSIDISATION OF
HOT ROLLED PLATE STEEL EXPORTED TO AUSTRALIA
FROM THE PEOPLES REPUBLIC OF CHINA, INDONESIA, JAPAN, THE
REPUBLIC OF KOREA AND TAIWAN**

The Australian Customs and Border Protection Service (Customs and Border Protection) has received the exporter questionnaire response submitted on behalf of Shanghai Tycoon Co. Ltd. This questionnaire response has not been marked 'For official use only' or 'Public Record version'. Customs and Border Protection require that both a 'For official use only' (confidential) version and a 'Public Record' (non-confidential) version of the exporter questionnaire response are provided.

The questionnaire response provided is incomplete because no information has been provided in several key sections and some of the information has not been provided in the format requested (for example Excel spreadsheets).

Notably, no sales information, accounting or cost information has been provided, including detailed sales transactions, income statements or turnover spreadsheets. Moreover, none of the requested spreadsheets in the questionnaire response were provided.

I am therefore satisfied that sufficient information has not been furnished to enable export prices to be determined, and regard Shanghai Tycoon Co. Ltd to be a non-cooperative exporter in the investigation. As a result I will rely on all other relevant information available to me in making my findings and recommendations.

Shanghai Tycoon Co. Ltd can still participate in the investigation by providing Customs and Border Protection with submissions relating to injury and causation and providing comment in relation to the findings and recommendations in the statement of essential facts.
