***LATE SUBMISSION FROM BISALLOY STEELS PTY LTD***

On the 11 September 2013, the Anti-Dumping Commission received a submission from Bisalloy Steels Pty Ltd (Bisalloy).

The Commission's final report on the investigation is due to be provided to the Minister on or before 16 September 2013.

Section 269TEA(4) of the Customs Act 1901 states that the Commissioner is not obliged to have regard to any submission made in response to the statement of essential facts (SEF) that is received more than 20 days after the publication of the SEF if to do so would, in the Commissioner's opinion, prevent the timely preparation of the report to the Minister.

In accordance with this provision and the imminent due date of the final report, the Delegate of the Anti-Dumping Commissioner will not have regard to this submission as to do so would prevent the timely preparation of the final report to the Minister.
