

AUSTRALIAN CUSTOMS DUMPING NOTICE NO 2012/04

CERTAIN ELECTRIC CABLES EXPORTED TO AUSTRALIA FROM THE PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF CHINA

Termination of investigation

Customs Act 1901 - Part XVB

On 9 September 2011, the Chief Executive Officer (CEO) of the Australian Customs and Border Protection Service (Customs and Border Protection) initiated an investigation into the alleged dumping of certain electric cables exported to Australia from the People's Republic of China. The investigation was initiated following an application lodged by Advance Cables Pty Ltd, Olex Cables Pty Ltd and Prysmian Power Cables & Systems Pty Ltd on behalf of the Australian industry producing like goods.

Public notification of initiation of the investigation was made on 9 September 2011 in *The Australian* newspaper and by Australian Customs Dumping Notice 2011/40 which also contains additional information regarding the investigation.

As a result of Customs and Border Protection's investigation, the CEO is satisfied that exports of electric cables from China to Australia have not been at dumped prices. The CEO therefore terminated the investigation in accordance with s.269TDA(1) of the *Customs Act 1901*.

In making his decision, the CEO considered submissions and information supplied by interested parties, submissions in response to statement of essential facts No. 178 published on 23 December 2011 and any other relevant information.

A notice of the decision to terminate was published in *The Australian* on 6 February 2012. Termination report No. 178 is available on Customs and Border Protection's website.

The applicants may request a review of the CEO's decision by lodging an application with the Trade Measures Review Officer in the approved form and manner within 30 days of the publication of this notice.
