## **Customs Tariff (Anti-Dumping) Act 1975**

## **Aluminium Road Wheels**

## exported from the People's Republic of China

Variation of notice pursuant to subsections 8(5), 8(5BA) and 10(3B) of the Customs Tariff (Anti-Dumping) Act 1975

I, CRAIG LAUNDY, Assistant Minister for Industry, Innovation and Science and Parliamentary Secretary to the Minister for Industry, Innovation and Science (Parliamentary Secretary), having decided to issue a notice pursuant to subsection 269ZZM(4) of the *Customs Act 1901* (the Act) in respect of aluminium road wheels described in that notice (the goods) exported to Australia from the People's Republic of China (China) by Pilotdoer Wheel Co. Ltd (Pilotdoer) and Zhejiang Yueling Co. Ltd (Yueling), <a href="DETERMINE">DETERMINE</a>, pursuant to subsection 8(5) of the *Customs Tariff* (Anti-Dumping) Act 1975 (the Dumping Duty Act), that the interim dumping duty payable on the goods is an amount worked out in accordance with the combination of fixed and variable duty method, specified in sub-regulations 5(2) and 5(3) of the *Customs Tariff* (Anti-Dumping) Regulation 2013.

I <u>DIRECT</u>, pursuant to subsection 10(3B) of the Dumping Duty Act, that interim countervailing duty payable on the goods exported to Australia from China by Yueling be ascertained as a proportion of the export price of the goods.

Pursuant to subsection 8(5BA) of the Dumping Duty Act, I have had regard to the desirability of specifying a method such that the sum of:

- (i) the export price of goods of that kind as so ascertained or last ascertained; and
- (ii) the interim dumping duty payable on the goods the subject of the notice under subsection 269TG(1) and (2); and
- (iii) the interim countervailing duty payable under section 10 of the Dumping Duty Act on goods the subject of the notice under section 269TJ of the Act;

does not exceed the non-injurious price of goods of that kind as ascertained, or last ascertained, for the purpose of those notices.

Pursuant to subsection 10(3D) of the Dumping Duty Act, I have had regard to the desirability of fixing the amount of interim countervailing duty such that the sum of:

- (a) the export price of goods of that kind, as ascertained, or last ascertained; and
- (b) that amount of the interim countervailing duty as so fixed; and
- (c) the amount of interim dumping duty as fixed under section 8 of the Dumping Duty Act:

does not exceed the non-injurious price of goods of that kind as ascertained, or last ascertained, for the purposes of those notices.

To preserve confidentiality, the ascertained export price will not be published. This notice applies to the goods and like goods entered for home consumption on and after 22 October 2015.
