ANTI-DUMPING NOTICE NO. 2016/44

Biodiesel

Exported from the United States of America Expiry of Anti-Dumping Measures

Anti-dumping measures, including dumping and countervailing duties, on biodiesel exported from the United States of America (USA) were initially imposed by public notice on 18 April 2011 by the then Minister for Home Affairs following consideration of *Trade Measures Report No. 163.*

On 13 July 2015, the Commissioner of the Anti-Dumping Commission (the Commissioner) published a notice in *The Australian* newspaper, in accordance with subsection 269ZHB(1) of the *Customs Act 1901*, inviting certain persons to apply to the Commissioner for the continuation of anti-dumping measures by 11 September 2015.

As no application was received, the anti-dumping measures applying to Biodiesel exported from the USA expired on 18 April 2016. Therefore, on and from <u>19 April 2016</u> anti-dumping measures no longer apply.
