**Prepared or preserved tomatoes from Italy**

As you will be aware, the Anti-Dumping Review Panel in this matter has requested a re-investigation by the Anti-Dumping Commission. The Panel has been informed by the Commission that a number of parties have raised with it, whether or not there will be an opportunity to make further submissions to the Panel after the Commission reports to the Panel on its re-investigation.

With regard to the issue of further submissions in response to the re-investigation report by the Commission, the Panel notes that in previous reviews it has not been the practice to have further submissions after a re-investigation report is received. If any party considers that there should be further submissions, please contact the Panel, providing reasons why such further submissions should be allowed. It would assist the Panel if such reasons could address the relevant provisions of the legislation and specifically the regard which can be had by the Panel to any further submissions, given s.269ZZK(4) and s.269ZZK(4A) of the Customs Act.

Given the further timetable for this review and, in particular, the requirement for the Panel to report to the Minister within 30 days of receipt of the re-investigation report, any approach to the Panel for further submissions, should be made no later than c.o.b. on Monday 18 August 2014.
