Notice under section 269ZZM(4)

Steel reinforcing bar exported from the Republic of Korea and Taiwan (with the exception of Power Steel Co. Ltd)

The Anti-Dumping Review Panel (ADRP) has completed a review of a decision which I, KAREN ANDREWS, Minister for Industry, Science and Technology made under subsection 269ZDB(1) of the *Customs Act 1901* in respect of steel reinforcing bar exported from the Republic of Korea and Taiwan (with the exception of Power Steel Co. Ltd) (the Reviewable Decision). The Reviewable Decision was published on the Anti-Dumping Commission (ADC) website on 31 May 2019 (ADN 2019/54).

An application for review of the Reviewable Decision was made by Liberty OneSteel (Newcastle) Pty Ltd. A copy of the application is available on the ADRP website at www.adreviewpanel.gov.au.

On 6 July 2020, the ADRP made its report to me (ADRP Report No. 108). A copy of this report is available on the ADRP website. Any confidential information contained in ADRP Report No. 108 has been removed from the version available on the ADRP website. If your confidential information forms part of ADRP Report No. 108, you can request a copy of your confidential information from the ADRP Secretariat via the details available on the ADRP website.

The ADRP has recommended that the Reviewable Decision be **revoked** and substituted with a new decision in the same terms as the Reviewable Decision except;

- That the normal values and non-injurious prices be adjusted for exports from Wei Chih and all other exporters from Taiwan (except for Power Steel Co. Ltd), resulting in a dumping margin of negative 0.9 per cent

I, KAREN ANDREWS, Minister for Industry, Science and Technology have considered and accepted the recommendations, and reasons for the recommendations, made by the ADRP in ADRP Report No. 108, including all material findings of fact or law as set out in ADRP Report No. 108.

Therefore, in accordance with section 269ZZM(1)(b) of the *Customs Act 1901*, I **revoke** the Reviewable Decision and substitute a new decision as recommended by the ADRP. The substituted decision is to have effect from 31 May 2019.

Applications for review of this decision under the *Administrative Decisions (Judicial Review) Act 1977* should be made to the Federal Court of Australia within 28 days after the later of:

- The publication of this notice; or
- If you obtain a copy of your confidential information forming part of ADRP Report No 108 – the day on which you receive that information.
