Notice under section 269ZZM(1B)

Ammonium Nitrate exported from the Russian Federation

The Anti-Dumping Review Panel (Review Panel) has completed a review of a decision by the former Minister for Industry, Science and Technology made under subsection 269ZHG(1) of the *Customs Act 1901* (the Act) in respect of Ammonium Nitrate exported from the Russian Federation (the Reviewable Decision). The Reviewable Decision was published on the Anti-Dumping Commission (ADC) website on 23 May 2021 (ADN 2021/053).

On 11 November 2022, the Review Panel finalised its report to me in accordance with section 269ZZK(3)(b)(ii) of the Act. On 20 December 2022, I extended the period of time to make a decision on the Review Panel's report until 13 February 2023 due to special circumstances.

My decision in relation to the Review Panel's report is due by 13 February 2023. However, I am satisfied that there are special circumstances that prevent a decision under section 269ZZM(1) being made by 13 February 2023 and that it is appropriate to further extend the period of time for making the decision to 13 April 2023.

Accordingly, I have decided under section 269ZZM(1A)(b) of the Act to extend the period for making my decision to 13 April 2023.
