Notice under section 269ZZM(4)

PVC Flat Electrical Cables exported from the People's Republic of China

The Anti-Dumping Review Panel (Review Panel) has completed a review of my decision made under subsection 269TG(2) of the *Customs Act 1901* in respect of certain polyvinyl chloride (PVC) Flat Electrical Cables exported from the People's Republic of China (the Reviewable Decision). The Reviewable Decision was published on the Anti-Dumping Commission (ADC) website on 1 September 2022 (ADN 2022/019).

An application for review of the Reviewable Decision was made by Electra Cables (Aust) Pty Limited. A copy of the application is available on the Review Panel website at www.adreviewpanel.gov.au.

On 19 January 2023, the Review Panel made its report to me (Report No. 160). A copy of this report is available on the Review Panel website. The Review Panel has recommended that the Reviewable Decision be affirmed.
