Notice under section 269ZZM(1B)

Ammonium Nitrate exported from the Russian Federation

The Anti-Dumping Review Panel (Review Panel) has completed a review of a decision by the former Minister for Industry, Science and Technology made under subsection 269ZHG(1) of the *Customs Act 1901* (the Act) in respect of Ammonium Nitrate exported from the Russian Federation (the Reviewable Decision). The Reviewable Decision was published on the Anti-Dumping Commission (ADC) website on 23 May 2021 (ADN 2021/053).

On 11 November 2022, the Review Panel finalised its report to me in accordance with section 269ZZK(3)(b)(ii) of the Act. Previously, I extended the period of time to make my decision until 13 October 2023. On 13 October 2023, I decided under section 269ZZM(1A)(b) of the Act to extend the time for making my decision until 13 November 2023. I considered there were special circumstances that prevented me from making a decision under section 269ZZM(1) by 13 October 2023.

I consider that special circumstances remain that prevent me from making a decision under section 269ZZM(1) by 13 November 2023. Accordingly, I have decided under section 269ZZM(1A)(b) of the Act to extend the time for making my decision until 13 May 2024.
