Direction under section 269ZYB(2)

Reconsideration of PVC Flat Electrical Cables exported from the People's Republic of China

On 11 January 2024, the Federal Court of Australia made orders setting aside Anti-Dumping Review Panel (Review Panel) Report No. 160 concerning PVC Flat Electrical Cables exported from the People's Republic of China and the matter was remitted to the Review Panel for reconsideration in accordance with law.

On 7 October 2022, the former Senior Member had directed under section 269ZYA of the *Customs Act 1901* (the Act) that the Review Panel for the purpose of this review be constituted by Review Panel Member, Andrew Stoler. Andrew Stoler has ceased to be available for the purpose of this review.

Pursuant to s.269ZYB(2) of the Act, I direct that the Review Panel for the review of the Reviewable Decision be reconstituted by Review Panel Member, Frank Schoneveld.
