Ammonium Nitrate exported from the Russian Federation

The Anti-Dumping Review Panel (Review Panel) has completed a review of a decision of the then Minister for Industry, Science and Technology made under subsection 269ZHG(1)(a) of the *Customs Act 1901* in respect of Ammonium Nitrate exported from the Russian Federation (the Reviewable Decision). The Reviewable Decision was published on the Anti-Dumping Commission (ADC) website on 23 May 2021 (ADN 2021/053).

Applications for review of the Reviewable Decision was made by CSBP Limited, Dyno Nobel Asia Pacific Pty Limited, Orica Australia Pty Ltd and Queensland Nitrates Pty Ltd. Copies of the applications are available on the Review Panel website at www.adreviewpanel.gov.au.
