I refer to your letter dated 16 August 2014 received by the Anti-Dumping Review Panel on 18 August 2014.

A number of interested parties have put to me that there should be a further round of submissions after the re-investigation by the Anti-Dumping Commission has been completed. This would allow interested parties to respond to any further or different findings made by the Commission.

I have reviewed the arguments put forward and I am grateful to those who addressed the legislative provisions, subsection 269ZZK(4) and (4A) of the Customs Act. However, I have come to the view that the legislation does not give a Panel member discretion to allow further submissions beyond those made pursuant to section 269ZZJ. Detailed reasons for this view will be provided with the report to the Parliamentary Secretary.
