#### GRINDING BALLS exported from the PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF CHINA

# Applicants: Commonwealth Steel Company Pty Ltd (trading as Moly-Cop Mining Consumables – Waratah Steel Mill)

The Anti-Dumping Review Panel (ADRP) review of Grinding Balls exported from the People's Republic of China was initiated on 12 July 2016. A copy of the public notice is attached.

To support the ADRP review, the ADRP Member requests the Anti-Dumping Commission (ADC) provide the following documents:

- 1. The Statement of Essential Facts (SEF) including any confidential attachments relevant to the grounds of the review application;
- 2. Any parties' submissions to the ADC commenting on the investigation of subsidisation including confidential attachments relevant to the grounds of the application for review;
- 3. Any confidential attachments to the Termination Report;
- 4. The calculations of countervailing margins for the applicant;
- 5. Any other *relevant information* (as defined in s269ZZK *Customs Act 1901*) pertinent to the grounds of review raised by the Applicant, for example:
  - Any other information in relation to subsidies identified in during the investigation and relied on in making the decision the subject of the review; and
- 6. Confidential visit reports of exporters the subject of the investigation, if relevant to the countervailing investigation.

### **Confidential and Public Documents**

Only confidential versions of documents need to be provided. Public versions of documents that have been published on the ADC website, including on the Electronic Public Record for the relevant case, are not required.

The ADRP Member requests the ADC provide the documents requested by 28 July 2016.
