ROD IN COILS Exported from the Republic of Indonesia and Taiwan

The Anti-Dumping Review Panel (ADRP) has completed a review of the decision by the former Parliamentary Secretary to the then Minister for Industry and Science to declare by public notice under s 269TG(1) and (2) of the *Customs Act 1901* (Customs Act) that s 8 of the *Customs Tariff (Anti-Dumping) Act 1975* applies in respect of Rod in Coils (goods) exported to Australia from the Republic of Indonesia (other than by PT Ispat Indo) and Taiwan (Reviewable Decision).

The Reviewable Decision was made on 3 June 2015 and the public notice of the Reviewable Decision was published on 17 June 2015.

Applications for review of the Reviewable Decision by the ADRP were made by PT Gunung Rajapaksi and OneSteel Manufacturing Pty Ltd. Copies of the applications and ADRP Report No 31 are available on the ADRP website <u>www.adreviewpanel.gov.au.</u>
