DEEP DRAWN STAINLESS STEEL SINKS Exported from the People's Republic of China

The Anti-Dumping Review Panel (ADRP) has completed a review of a decision by the Parliamentary Secretary to the former Minister for Industry and Science to vary a dumping duty notice and countervailing duty notice in respect of Deep Drawn Stainless Steel Sinks exported from the People's Republic of China. This decision was published in the Australian newspaper on 26 March 2015 (the Reviewable Decision).

The applications for review were made by Everhard Industries Pty Ltd and Milena Australia Pty Ltd. A copy of the applications and the ADRP Report to me is available on the ADRP website www.adreviewpanel.gov.au.

The ADRP has recommended that I affirm the Reviewable Decision.

I, KAREN ANDREWS, Parliamentary Secretary to the Minister for Industry, Innovation and Science, have considered the recommendations and reasons for the recommendations made by the member of the ADRP, including all material findings of fact or law as set out in ADRP Report No. 22 dated 11 September 2015. In accordance with section 269ZZM(1)(a) of the *Customs Act 1901* I affirm the Reviewable Decision. This decision has effect from the date of this notice.

Interested parties may seek a review of this decision by lodging an application with the Federal Court of Australia, in accordance with the requirements in the Administrative Decisions (Judicial Review) Act 1977, within 28 days of the publication of this notice.
