ROD IN COILS EXPORTED FROM THE REPUBLIC OF INDONESIA AND TAIWAN

**Notice of longer period for the decision of the Assistant Minister for
Science/Parliamentary Secretary to the Minister for Industry,
Innovation and Science**

The Anti-Dumping Review Panel (ADRP) has completed a review of a decision by me to publish a dumping duty notice in relation to Rod in Coils exported from the Republic of Indonesia and Taiwan.

The applications for review were made by PT GUNUNG RAJAPAKSI and ONESTEEL MANUFACTURING PTY LTD ('OneSteel'). A copy of the applications and submission made in relation to the applications is available on the ADRP website www.adreviewpanel.gov.au.

The ADRP provided its report and recommendation to me on 22 January 2016. Subsection 269ZM(1A) of the *Customs Act 1901* requires that I must make a decision in regard to that review within 30 days after receiving that report. This required me to make my decision by 22 February 2016. Where I consider special circumstances prevent my decision being made within that period, it may be made within such longer period as I consider appropriate.

On 11 February 2016 as a result of special circumstances, I decided under section 269ZM(1A) of the *Customs Act 1901* to extend the period for making my decision for a further 30 days to **23 March 2016**.
