Description: The Hunter Gas Pipeline (HGP) is an 833km underground gas pipeline that has planning approval from the NSW and QLD governments. Santos acquired the HGP on 11 August 2022. Once constructed, it will potentially connect the Wallumbilla Gas Supply Hub in Queensland to NSW. The HGP comprises two stages; Stage 1 – Narrabri to Hexham ~ 413km and Stage 2 – Narrabri to Wallumbilla ~ 420km.
