Purpose: Upgrade existing facility

Capital expenditure: \$500 million or more

Description: Julimar Development Phase 3 (JDP3) is a subsea tieback opportunity expanding on the existing Wheatstone Platform, processing facilities and subsea production infrastructure from earlier phases. This development currently includes an additional five production wells (with an option of a sixth pending 2023 appraisal), manifold and associated flowlines. Woodside Energy (Woodside) is operator of the Julimar Brunello fields with a 65% interest (KUFPEC 35%) and supplies natural gas to the Wheatstone LNG facility operated by Chevron. The completion date for the project has not yet been finalised. The project is subject to a final investment decision to proceed. Once FID is taken, a target completion date will be advised.

Feedback process for unsuccessful bidders:

Procurement entities will assess the Australian entities nominated by ICNWA or other Company-appointed independent industry capability verification service provider and advise them in writing which Australian entities were invited to tender, and which were excluded from the tender list and the reasons for their exclusions. Should an Australian entity excluded from the tender list, request feedback, ICNWA on behalf of the Procurement entity will provide such feedback as appropriate, recommend areas for improvement and referrals to support services. At the conclusion of a tendering process, unsuccessful bidders will be advised by procurement entities and will be offered the opportunity for feedback.
