Description: Harmony is a 70-year-old mining company headquartered in South Africa and listed on the Johannesburg and New York stock exchanges.

In FY2022 Harmony produced 1.49 million ounces of gold with US\$2.8bn of revenue and approximately US\$500m of EBITDA. Harmony is the largest gold producer by volume in South Africa and is a significant operator of gold tailings retreatment facilities. In Papua New Guinea, Harmony owns and operates the Hidden Valley mine and owns 50% of the tier-1 Wafi-Golpu copper-gold project.

In December 2022, Harmony acquired 100% of the Eva Copper Project, a near term copper project in North-West Queensland, Australia.

The Eva Copper Project is envisioned to be an open pit mine with a conventional crush, two-stage grind and flotation circuit for the production of copper and gold concentrates from seven open-pit deposits. Harmony is updating the feasibility study and progressing front-end-engineering and design throughout 2023 prior to a final investment decision (FID).

Once FID is achieved, construction of the mine and processing facility is expected to take up to 36 months. Project construction will include a 300-person accommodation village on site plus administration buildings, maintenance, training and first-aid facilities.

The project is expected to produce 100 million pounds of copper and 14,000 ounces of gold per annum over the life of the mine.
