## Project details

Name: Western Renewables Link

Location: Central and western Victoria between Bulgana and Sydenham

Type: Other productive facility

Purpose: Establish new facility

Capital expenditure: \$500 million or more

Description: The Western Renewables Link (WRL) is a proposed new 190km overhead high-voltage electricity transmission line that will carry renewable energy from Bulgana in western Victoria to Sydenham in Melbourne's north-west. The proposed project includes the redevelopment of two terminal stations, Bulgana terminal station and Sydenham terminal station to support the new transmission lines and protection, control, monitoring, communications system modifications at existing terminal stations surrounding the route of the proposed new line. The project is critical infrastructure required to unlock the renewable energy potential of western Victoria as a key Renewable Energy Zone and will help to deliver clean and affordable energy to all Victorians. AusNet intends to select and engage a main construction partner who will have primary responsibility for the procurement of goods and services in relation to the Project. A separate construction partner is intended to be selected for the redevelopment of Sydenham terminal station. Under AusNet's proposed agreements, the construction partners will be contractually required to comply with the AIP Plan. The anticipated timeframe for the engagement of the construction partners is late 2024 with the potential for advanced procurement activities to commence 2025.
